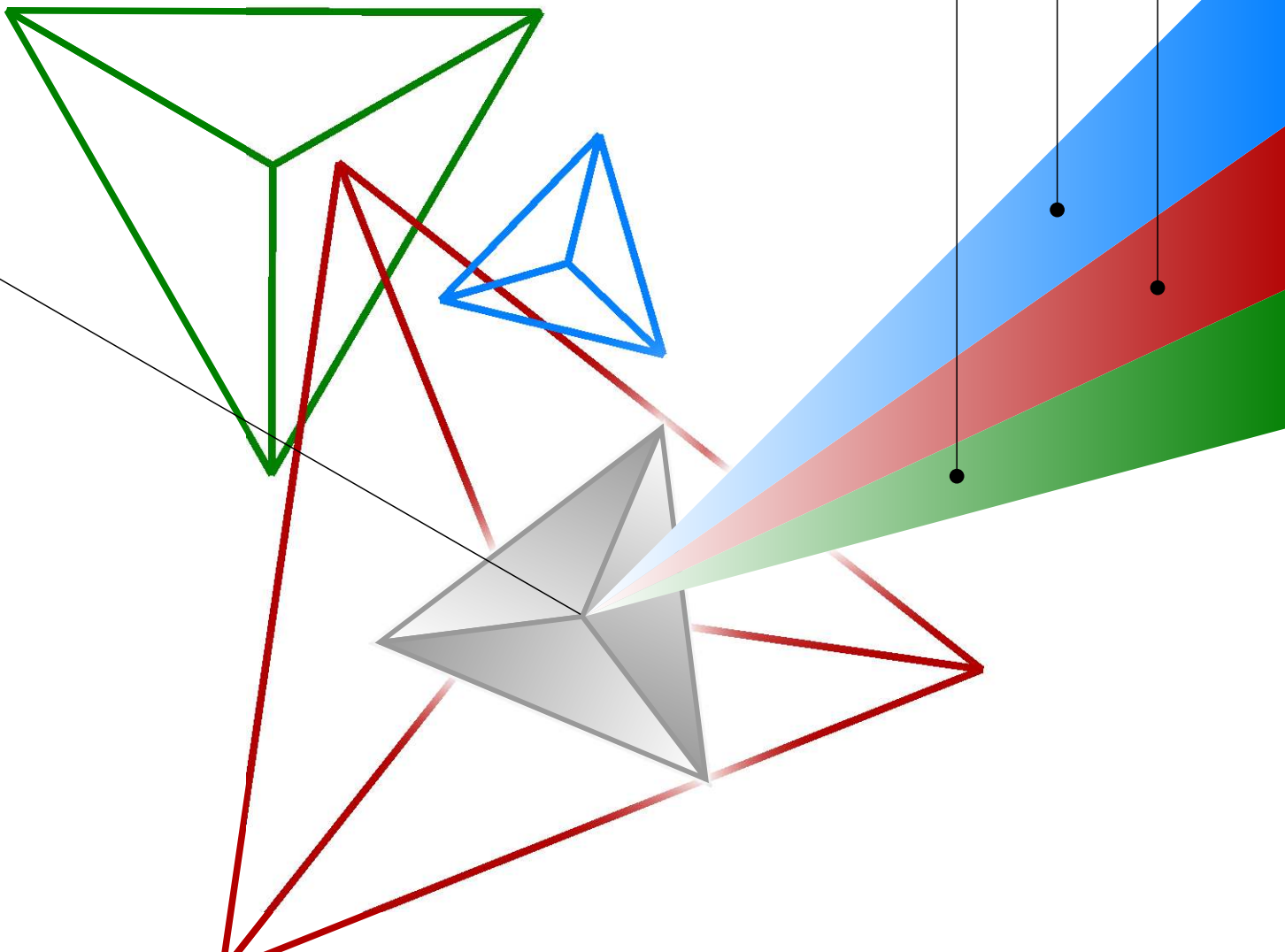

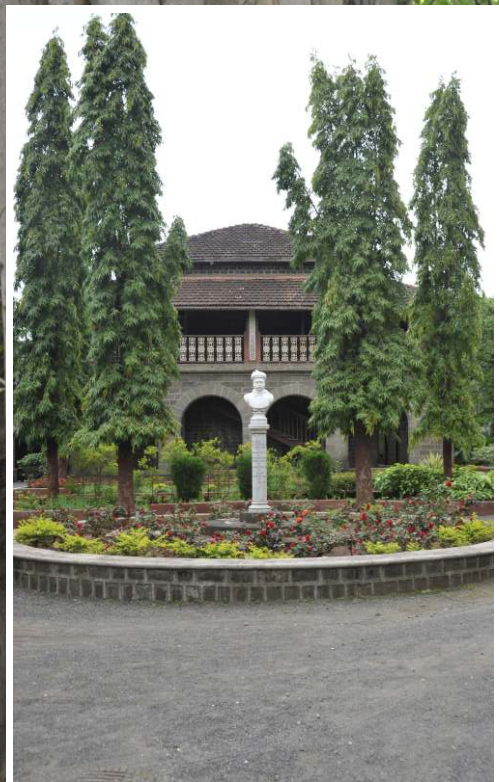
1. A+ rating (score 90 – 95%).

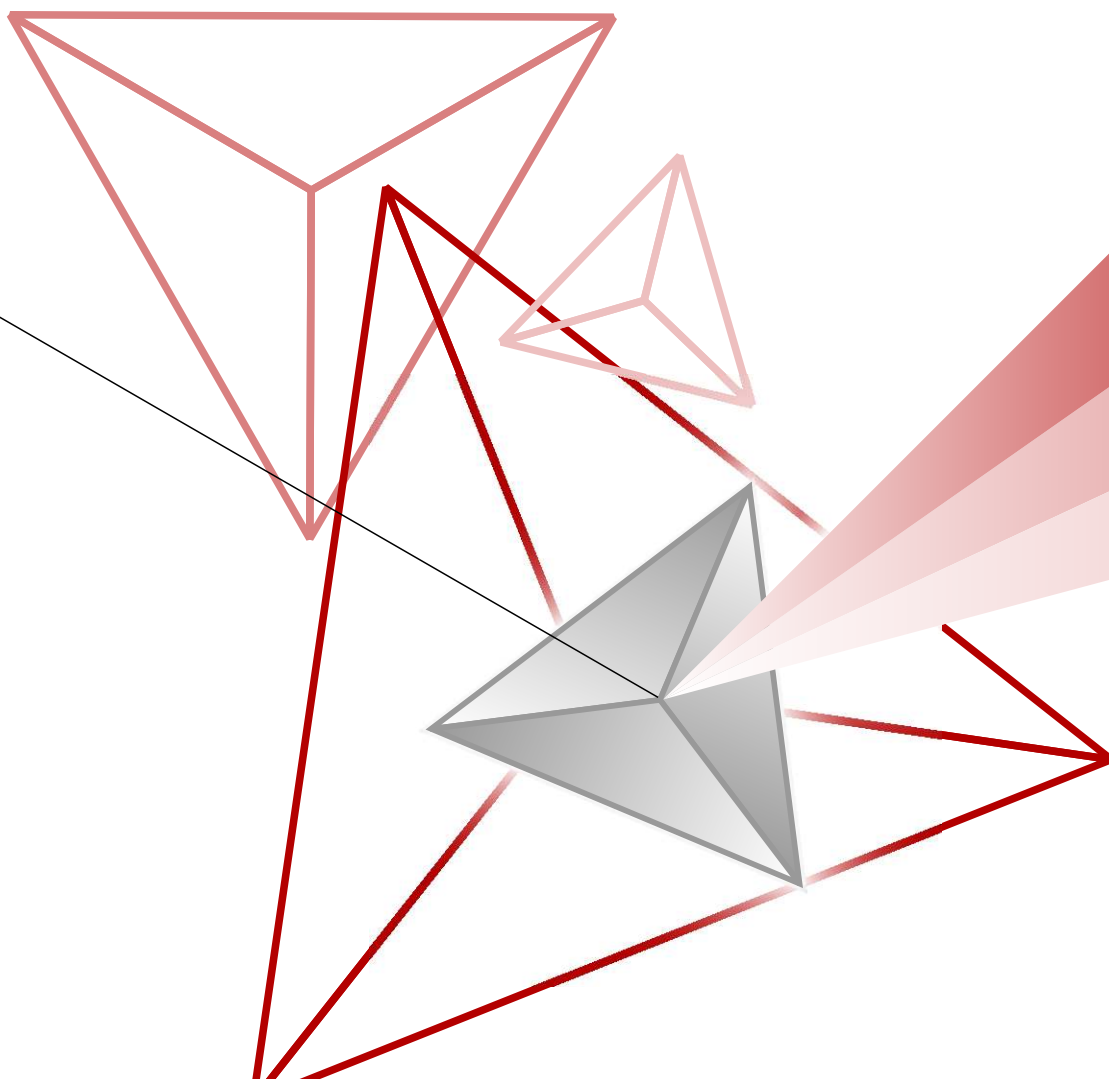

The two year Master's degree in Economics is a postgraduate academic program, offering training in economic and development theory, econometrics, applied finance, policy making and quantitative techniques, which together help to study the various critical segments of the economy, thereby making a special value addition to the students. PLACEMENT PROCESS

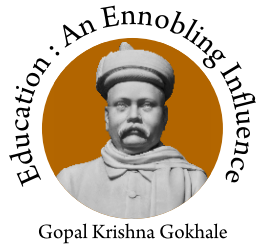
