Course Syllabus

Description:

The objective of the Taleem al-Qur'an Correspondence Course (CC) is to provide individuals with the opportunity to study the Qur'an at their own pace. This course is designed to make the teachings of Islam easily accessible. The course consists of three core elements. These are the three T's: 1) Tajweed, 2) Translation and Word analysis and 3) Tafsir. It is intended for students who are unable to attend any of the regular courses online or on-campus due to various circumstances. It is implemented by providing lectures through a web-based learning platform. Students will be able to access audio lectures, write tests, and assignments at their own convenience.

Goals:

The CC facilitates learning with the following objectives:

- Recite the Qur'an with rules of Tajweed
- Understand the Qur'an directly in Arabic
- Know the Tafsir (explanation) of the Qur'an
- Adapt to the teachings of the Qur'an

Course Schedule:

The students will have the opportunity to work independently at the pace they choose. The minimum number of lessons they are required to complete is one lesson per week. Students' attendance and progress will be kept track of. It is recommended that students start with one lesson per week then increase the number of lessons at their own ease. Getting into a routine is important!

Note: Each lesson includes Tajweed (reciting along with the teacher, with a requirement of minimum three repetitions per lesson), Translation and Word Analysis (writing and taking notes), Tafsir (noting all the important points).

Withdrawal:

Absence without notification:

A warning will be issued if a student remains absent for 3 sessions with the Lesson in charge without providing prior notification.
